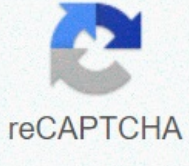

In addition, Colorado allows you to do your "self-proving" will and you will have to go to a notary if you want to. A self-provement will speed up the debate because the court can accept the will without contacting the witnesses who signed it. To make your will self-provoking you and your witnesses will go to the notary and sign a affidavit that shows who you are and that each of you knew you were signing the will. Colo. Rev. Stat. In Colorado, you can use your will to appoint a personal representative who will ensure that the provisions of your will are made after your death. In Colorado, you can revoke or change your will at any time. However, if you only have very simple changes to make, you could add an amendment to your existing will - this is called a code. In both cases, you need to finalize changes with the same formalities you used to make your original will (see above). If you and your spouse are divorced (or if a court determines that your marriage is not legal), the Colorado law revokes any language in your will that leaves ownership to your spouse or names that your spouse is your executor.
